

If your ID / DL was issued within 6 months, please provide a copy of that ID / DL (front and back) along with 5-7 secondary forms of ID that are at least 6 months old. Make sure you make copies of the front and back of any cards.

These documents are not acceptable as secondary identification when presented alone.

Example: Social Security Card + Credit Card + School ID

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If you can only come up with 2-3 of the above then also submit a DS-71 form (An Identifying Witness) that can only be obtained at the passport acceptance clerk:

An identifying witness is a person who can swear to your identity. He or she must:

- Be present at the time of application
- Have known you for at least 2 years
- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Have valid ID
